**CHRIST
ALONE**

This is a fitting theme for this year's RDC. It was 450 years ago that the Reformed creed, the **Belgic Confession**, was published in 1561. The author of this confession, Guido de Bres, lived and died by this motto of "**Christ Alone**". It is thus fitting that Reformation Day Conference pays attention to his contributions.

The Lectures

The speaker, Pastor Winston Huizinga, will focus on two **sola** statements.

- The first will be **sola Scriptura** or the Scriptures alone. This deals with the return to the Bible. Instead of using relics, superstitious rites and sacramentalism, and the worship of saints, the reformers used the Scriptures which focus all attention on Christ, insisting that He alone is the way, the truth and the life.
- The second sola statement concerns **sola gratia**. By grace alone focuses all attention on Jesus as our only and complete Saviour. Not good works, not the payment of funds for conducting a mass or for an indulgence, but grace alone saves us. This is not our doing, but the work of Christ alone.



Introduction to Pastor Winston Huizinga

Pastor Winston Huizinga was a minister of the Free Reformed Church of Armadale in Perth, Western Australia for over 25 years. He retired this year. Before going to Australia, he had served Canadian Reformed Churches in London, Watford and Hamilton in the province of Ontario in Canada.

After graduating with a BA Honours, Pastor Huizinga studied theology at the Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia for a year before moving to the Canadian Reformed Churches' seminary in Hamilton, from which he graduated. While serving full-time in Hamilton and Armadale, he undertook a Master of Theology degree in New Testament studies under Dr Prof J Van Bruggen at the Theological University at Kampen, The Netherlands.

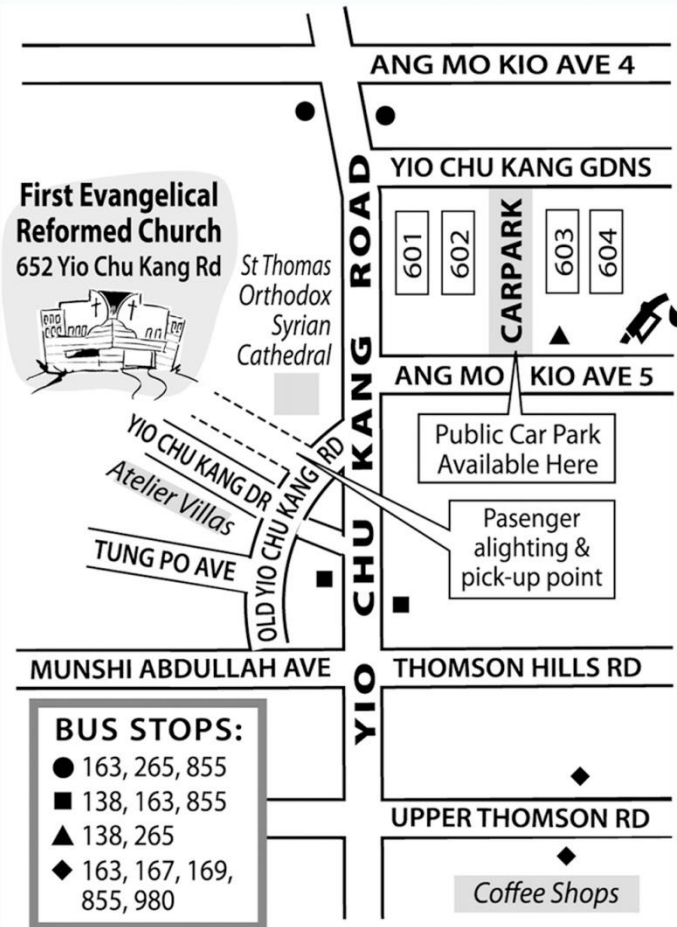

If you are commuting by MRT or bus, the following directions may be helpful.

1. You can take bus #138 from Ang Mo Kio Bus Interchange (linked to Ang Mo Kio MRT Station) to the bus stop that is just opposite FERC. Alight at the 9th bus stop after the bus leaves the interchange, which is also the 1st bus stop along Yio Chu Kang Road after the bus turns out from Ang Mo Kio Ave 5.
2. Buses #163 and # 855 also stop outside/opposite our church along Yio Chu Kang Road.
3. Other buses that stop at nearby bus stops are shown in the map .
